Frequently Asked Questions

1) Which meetings am I invited to attend?

You are invited to attend the NMFTA, CCSB, and CRC meetings as well as any of the subcommittees (i.e. Commerce, Government Relations, Weighing & Research, Carrier Procedures, and Outreach). The Board of Directors meeting is closed to all but board members.

2) What is the protocol for introductions during the meetings?

At the beginning of the NMFTA meeting, please stand and provide your name and your company name. At the beginning of the CRC meeting, please stand and provide your name and the state/region you represent.

3) What is the appropriate attire for the business meetings?

We want our meetings to be comfortable and relaxed for our attendees, so business casual is appropriate.

4) What is the appropriate attire for the scheduled receptions and dinners?

We suggest a suit, dress, or pants for ladies and a suit or sport coat with tie optional for the gentlemen.

5) Am I responsible for any of the costs or fees associated with the business meetings/special activities?

NMFTA sponsors all business meetings/special activities (i.e. various outings and scheduled receptions, breakfasts, lunches, and dinners). NMFTA reimburses transportation expenses incurred in traveling to and from the meetings. (See NMFTA Travel Reimbursement Policy).

6) What cost or fees am I responsible for?

You are responsible for your hotel room costs, and any other miscellaneous fees or incidentals you may incur.

7) Can my spouse also attend the special activities and the scheduled receptions, breakfasts, lunches, and dinners?
