CRC OFFICER ELECTION RESULTS - NMFTA|CCSB|CRC MEETING IN ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA

Classification Resource Committee (CRC) officer election results.

Alexandria, VA --- The annual elections for the Classification Resource Committee (CRC) officers took place during the October, 2009 National Motor Freight Traffic Association, Inc. (NMFTA) | Commodity Classification Standards Board (CCSB) | CRC meetings. The officers elected to serve one year terms are as follows:

NMFTA's Classification Resource Committee (CRC) consists of up to 100 members elected from the 50 states, the District of Columbia, Canada and Mexico to represent motor carriers that participate in the National Motor Freight Classification (NMFC). Any officer, owner or employee of a participating motor carrier can become a member of the CRC.

The CRC provides information and other resources to the CCSB on matters relating to the content of the National Motor Freight Classification (NMFC). It provides information on classification research activities, the transportation characteristics of products moving via motor carrier and on motor carrier operations. The CRC may make recommendations and give advice regarding the Policies and Directives for developing and maintaining the NMFC. Like anyone or any group having an interest in the content of the NMFC, the CRC can formulate and submit proposals to amend the NMFC. However, the CRC makes no decisions with respect to the disposition of those proposals.

The next meeting of the NMFTA | CCSB | CRC will take place in February 2010 in Tampa, Florida. Both the CCSB and CRC meetings are open to the public and all parties interested in the classification process are welcome to attend.
