The National Motor Freight Traffic Association Launches SPLC Online

Alexandria, VA—The National Motor Freight Traffic Association, Inc. (NMFTA) has released ***SPLC Online***, the online version of the ***Continental Directory of Standard Point Location Codes (SPLC)***. The online version allows users to more easily search the entire database that presently contains over 213,000 records for locations in the United States, Canada and Mexico as well as provide timely updates. SPLC Online joins the full range of NMFTA online products to include National Motor Freight Classification – ClassIT 2.0 and Standard Carrier Alpha Code – SCAC Online. NMFTA will no longer be providing the SPLC Directory in print form.

The Standard Point Location Code is specifically designed to provide each transportation origin and destination point in North America with a unique 9-digit code number to identify the point with its geographic location. The code sequence is: State--County--City--Sub-Code.
